- (2) The proceeds of such tax shall constitute a separate fund called the public library fund and shall not be used for any purpose except those of the public library.
- (3) No money shall be paid out of the public library fund by the treasurer of the city or county except by order

or warrant of the board of library trustees.

(4) Bonds may be issued by the governing body in the manner prescribed by law for the erection and equipment of public library buildings and the purchase of land therefor.

Insert: "(2)(a) The governing body of any city or county may by resolution submit the question of exceeding the maximum tax levy provided in subsection (1) to a vote of the qualified electors thereof at the next general election. Such resolution must be adopted at least 60 days prior to the general election at which the question will be voted on.

- (b) Upon petition being filed with the governing body and signed by not less than 5% of the resident taxpayers of any city or county requesting an election for the purpose of exceeding the maximum mill levy, the governing body shall submit to a vote of the qualified electors thereof at the next general election the question of exceeding the maximum mill levy. Such petition must be delivered to the governing body at least 90 days prior to the general election at which the question will be voted on.
- (c) The question shall be submitted by ballots upon which the words "FOR exceeding themill maximum levy and authorizing an additionalmill(s) for the library" and "AGAINST exceeding themill maximum library levy" shall appear, with a square before each proposition and a direction to insert an "X" mark in the square before one or the other of the propositions.
- (d) The votes cast for the adoption or rejection of the question must be canvassed, and:
- (i) if a majority of the voters voting on the question vote to exceed the maximum mill levy, the governing body shall levy the additional tax for the year in which the vote was taken; or
- (ii) if a majority of the voters voting on the question vote to not exceed the maximum mill levy, the maximum mill levy may not be exceeded."
