Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.


DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

House Bill 216 proposes to provide Districting and Apportionment Commission members with the same pay and allowances as members of the legislature.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Any fiscal impact will not be felt until 1989, at the earliest. What pay and allowances will apply then cannot be predicted. Had the proposed law been in effect for the past two years, commission members would have received about twice the \$20 a day salary now authorized, for about 20 to 25 days.
