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A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO CHANGE THE PROTEST PROVISION FOR THE ADOPTION OF COUNTY ZONING DISTRICTS FROM 40 PERCENT TO 60 PERCENT OF THE FREEHOLDERS IN THE DISTRICT: AMENDING SECTION 76-2-205- MCA."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANAS

Section 1. Section 76-2-205, MCA, is amended to read:

*76-2-205. Procedure for adoption of regulations and boundaries. The board of county commissioners shall observe the following procedures in the establishment or revision of boundaries for zoning districts and in the adeption or amendment of zoning regulations:

- (1) Notice of a public hearing on the proposed zoning district boundaries and of regulations for the zoning district shall be published once a week for 2 weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the county. The notice shall state:
 - (a) the boundaries of the proposed district;
- 22 (b) the general character of the proposed zoning 23 regulations:
 - (c) the time and place of the public hearing:
 - (d) that the proposed zoning regulations are on file

for public inspection at the office of the county clerk and 1 ' 2 recorder.

- 3 (2) At the public hearings the board of county commissioners shall give the public an opportunity to be heard regarding the proposed zoning district and requiations.
- (3) After the public hearings the board of county 7 commissioners shall review the proposals of the planning board and shall make such revisions or amendments as it may deem proper.
- (4) The board of county commissioners may pass a 11 resolution of intention to create a zoning district and to 12 adopt zoning regulations for the district. • 13
 - 14 (5) The board of county commissioners shall publish 15 notice of passage of the resolution of intention once a week 16 for 2 weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the 17 county. The notice shall state:
 - (a) the boundaries of the proposed district:
 - 19 (b) the general character of the proposed zoning 20 requiations;
 - 21 (c) that the proposed zoning regulations are on file 22 for public inspection at the office of the county clerk and 23 recorder:
 - 24 (d) that for 30 days after first publication of this notice, the board of county commissioners will receive 25

written protests to the creation of the zoning district or to the zoning regulations from persons owning real property within the district whose names appear on the last completed assessment roll of the county.

period, the board of county commissioners may in its discretion adopt the resolution creating the zoning district and/or establishing the zoning regulations for the district; but if 40% 60% of the freeholders within such district whose names appear on the last completed assessment roll shall have protested the establishment of the district or adoption of the regulations, the board of county commissioners shall not adopt the resolution and no further zoning resolution shall be proposed for the district for a period of 1 year.

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
