A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REQUIRING REPORTS FROM

OPERATORS OF MOBILE HOME PARKS OF MOVEMENTS OF MOBILE HOMES;

AND PROVIDING PENALTIES."

 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Reporting movement of mobile homes. The owner or operator of any mobile home park or of any location where more than one mobile home may be parked shall, within 10 days after the arrival or departure of a mobile home, report to the county assessor and to the county treasurer the movement into or out of such park of any mobile home. The report must be on a form provided by the county assessor.

Section 2. Penalty for failure to report. Failure to file a report required in [section 1] is a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more than \$100. Conviction of a second and subsequent offense is punishable by a fine of not less than \$100 or more than \$500.

Section 3. Codification instruction. Sections 1 and 2 are intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 15, chapter 24, part 2, and the provisions of Title 15, chapter 24, part 2, apply to sections 1 and 2.
