DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

House Bill 249 eliminates the requirement that a store obtain a store license from the Department of Revenue.


ASSUMPTION:

- 1) Under continuation of the present law, it is assumed that store license fees would total \$290,000 annually during the 84-85 biennium.
