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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA: 9 Section 1. Section 13-27-410, MCA, is amended to read: 10 #13-27-410, Printing and distribution of voter 11 information pamphlet. (1) The secretary of state shall 12 arrange with the department of administration by requisition 13 for the printing and delivery of a voter information 14 pamphlet for all ballot issues to be submitted to the people 15 at least 90 days before the election at which they will be 16 submitted. The requisition shall include a delivery list 17 providing for shipment of the required number of pamphlets 18 19 to each county and to the secretary of state.

(2) The secretary of state shall estimate the number
of copies necessary to furnish one copy to every voter in
each county, except that two or more voters with the same
mailing address and the same last name may be counted as one
voter. The secretary of state shall provide for an extra
supply of the pamphlets in determining the number of voter

1 pamphlets to be ordered in the requisition.

(3) The department of administration shall call for
bids and contract with the lowest bidder for the printing
and delivery of the voter information pamphlet. The contract
shall require completion of printing and shipment, as
specified on the delivery list, of the voter information
pamphlets by not later than 30 days before the election at
which the ballot issues will be voted on by the people.

9 (4) The county official responsible for voter 10 registration in each county shall mail one copy of the voter 11 information pamphlet to each registered voter in the county. except that two or more voters with the same mailing address 12 13 and the same last name may be counted as one voter. The 14 mailing shall take place no later than 2 weeks after the 15 pamphlets are received from the printer. The department of 16 administration shall reimburse each county for the actual cost of postage for mailing voter information pamphlets to 17 18 voters in that county.

19 (5) Ten copies of the voter information pamphlet shall
20 be available at each precinct for use by any voter wishing
21 to read the explanatory information and complete text before
22 voting on the ballot issues."

In compliance with a written request received <u>January 21</u>, 19 <u>83</u>, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for <u>House Bill 288</u> pursuant to Title 5, Chapter 4, Part 2 of the Montana Code Annotated (MCA).

Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

House Bill 288 is an act requiring the Department of Administration to reimburse counties for the cost of mailing voter information pamphlets.

ASSUMPTION:

- 1) Estimates are based on postage only and do not include split shipments to respective destinations for mailing.
- 2) Assumes 90% of 1982 printing were distributed by mail.
- 3) Assumes current bulk rate mailing costs of 10.9¢ per piece.
- 4) Assumes 2% growth rate per year in voter registration.
- 5) Assumes 5% increase in postal rate per year.
- 6) Assumes growth of pamphlet from 32 pages to 48 pages.
