2 INTRODUCED BY Bullock  
3 BY REQUEST OF THE PERSONNEL AND LABOR RELATIONS  
4 STUDY COMMISSION  
5  
6 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO ALLOW THE BOARD OF  
7 PERSONNEL APPEALS TO HIRE ITS OWN STAFF; AMENDING SECTION  
8 2-15-1705, MCA."  
9  
10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:  
11 Section 1. Section 2-15-1705, MCA, is amended to read:  
12 "2-15-1705. Board of personnel appeals -- allocation  
13 -- composition -- vote necessary for decision --  
14 quasi-judicial. (1) There is a board of personnel appeals.  
15 (2) The board is allocated to the department of labor  
16 and industry for administrative purposes only as prescribed  
17 in 2-15-121, except that the board may hire its own staff.  
18 (3) The board consists of five members appointed by  
19 the governor. Two members shall represent management, two  
20 members shall represent employees or employee organizations  
21 of the state, and one member shall represent a neutral  
22 position.  
23 (4) When the member representing a neutral position is  
24 unable to participate in a proceeding before the board, an  
25 equal number of management and labor members of the board

1 shall select an individual, who shall be a neutral person,  
2 to serve in the place of the neutral member in that  
3 proceeding and he shall participate in the decision in that  
4 proceeding. There shall be only one additional neutral  
5 person appointed and serving at any one time. The  
6 individual selected is entitled to the same compensation and  
7 per diem that members of the board receive.  
8 (5) In all proceedings before the board, a favorable  
9 vote of at least a majority of a quorum is sufficient to  
10 adopt any resolution, motion, or other decision.  
11 (6) The board is designated a quasi-judicial board for  
12 purposes of 2-15-124."
