BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 2-15-1705, MCA, is amended to read:

"2-15-1705. Board of personnel appeals -- allocation

composition -- vote necessary for decision -
quasi-judicial. (1) There is a board of personnel appeals.

- (2) The board is allocated to the department of labor and industry for administrative purposes only as prescribed in 2-15-121, except that the board may hire its own staff.
- (3) The board consists of five members appointed by the governor. Two members shall represent management, two members shall represent employees or employee organizations of the state, and one member shall represent a neutral position.
- (4) When the member representing a neutral position is unable to participate in a proceeding before the board, an equal number of management and labor members of the board

shall select an individual, who shall be a neutral person,

to serve in the place of the neutral member in that

proceeding and he shall participate in the decision in that

proceeding. There shall be only one additional neutral

person appointed and serving at any one time. The

6 individual selected is entitled to the same compensation and

7 per diem that members of the board receive.

8 (5) In all proceedings before the board, a favorable
9 vote of at least a majority of a quorum is sufficient to
10 adopt any resolution, motion, or other decision.

11 (6) The board is designated a quasi-judicial board for 12 purposes of 2-15-124.\*\*
