#### DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

House Bill 335 increases the license fees for activities requested by the Department of Fish, Wildlife and Parks.

#### ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1) The estimated effect on revenue from the proposed license increases is based upon projections of the number of licenses that will be sold at the new fee rate. The projected number of licenses that will sell under the new fee structure includes a 12% factor for buyer resistance. This factor was arrived at through an analysis of the effect of fee increases in Montana over the past ten years, and from information reviewed from three other states.
- 2) We cannot provide expenditures by category. The expenditure budget is not allocated by category for each funding source.
- 3) The increased funding from the proposed license fee increase is budgeted primarily for new and expanded programs and capitol construction.

#### STATEMENT OF INTENT

#### HOUSE BILL 335

A statement of intent is required for House Bill 335 because section 3 provides that the Fish and Game Commission will designate the areas in which surplus eew ANILERLESS elk may be taken with a Class A-7 cow ANILERLESS elk license. In addition, the Commission may set times during the regular big game season for the taking of surplus cow ANILERLESS elk in designated areas.

The intent of the Class A-7 cow ANTLERLESS elk license is to provide the Commission with the option to issue cow ANTLERLESS elk licenses. The Commission would, with appropriate public comment, authorize cow ANTLERLESS elk licenses to be used in problem areas where additional cow ANTLERLESS elk need to be harvested. Class A-7 cow ANTLERLESS elk license holders would not be allowed to harvest a bull elk in the designated areas for the time period authorized by the Commission for the cow ANTLERLESS elk license.

The Class A-7 eew ANILERLESS elk license would not replace the need for or use of the eew ANILERLESS OR EITHER SEX elk permits now in place. The Class A-7 eew ANILERLESS elk license would provide additional flexibility for the Commission to deal with problems of surplus eew ANILERLESS

elk, particularly on private land.
