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A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO ENCOURAGE THE BREEDING AND RACING OF MONTANA HORSES BY ALLOCATION OF AN ADDITIONAL 1 PERCENT OF PARIMUTUEL GROSS RECEIPTS TO OWNERS OF MONTANA-BRED HORSES; AMENDING SECTION 23-4-304, MCA.**

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 23-4-304, MCA; is amended to read: "23-4-304. Gross receipts -- department's percentage -- collection and allocation. [1] The licensee shall pay to the department 1% of the gross receipts of each day's parimutuel betting at each race meet, which sums shall be paid to the department within 5 days after receipt by the licensee. At the end of each race meet the licensee shall prepare a report to the department showing the amount of the overpayments and underpayments. If the report shows the underpayments to be in excess of the overpayments, the balance shall be paid to the department. Money paid to the department may be used for the expenses incurred in carrying out this chapter.

(2) In addition to the sums paid under subsection (1). each licensee shall pay to the department 1% of the gross receipts of each day's parimutuel betting at each race meet

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

House Bill 351 encourages the breeding and racing of Montana horses by allocation of an additional one percent of parimutuel gross receipts to owners of Montana-bred horses and amends Section 23-4-304, MCA.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1) Assume October 1, 1983 effective date.
- 2) Will not be in effect until end of racing season in October, 1984 (FY 85) therefore no fiscal impact on FY 84.
- 3) Revenue from parimutuel gross receipts will remain constant.
- 4) 1% of parimutuel receipts is \$187,000.
