In compliance with a written request received January 22, , 19 83 , there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for House Bill 427 pursuant to Chapter 53, Laws of Montana, 1965 - Thirty-Ninth Legislative Assembly.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

House Bill 427 transfers the responsibility for control of state government data processing from the budget director to the director of the Department of Administration.

ASSUMPTIONS:


- 1) The new functions associated with this bill will be performed with existing current level staff (ie, 124.45 FTE). Therefore, no additional FTE's or personal services expenditures are needed.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Funding for the establishment of an equipment pool should be delayed until an equipment management plan has been established. Therefore, no additional expense is anticipated at this time.

Proper implementation of the planning, coordination and control measures specified in this bill will reduce the state's expenditure for data processing resources by minimizing unnecessary duplication of equipment, data, programs and related services. No dollar estimate can be made, though.
