A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO INCREASE THE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF LAWS RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION, OPERATION, AND ACCIDENT REPORTS; AMENDING SECTIONS 61-3-601, 61-3-704, 61-6-304, AND 61-7-111, MCA."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 61-3-601, MCA, is amended to read:

"61-3-601. Penalty for violations. Except as otherwise
provided, a violation of any of the provisions of this
chapter is a misdemeanor and is punishable by a fine not
exceeding \$25 \$500 or imprisonment in the county jail for a
term not exceeding 6 months or both such fine and
imprisonment. Nothing contained herein prevents the
prosecution of a person for an offense committed under any
other law."

Section 2. Section 61-3-704, MCA, is amended to read:

"61-3-704. Penalty. Any person operating a vehicle in violation of the intent and purpose of 61-3-701 or 61-3-702 shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not tess—than—\$10--or more than \$50 \$500 or confined in the county jail for not more than 30-days 5 months or both such fine and imprisonment."

Section 3. Section 61-6-304, MCA, is amended to read: \*61-6-304. Penalties. It is unlawful for any person to operate a motor vehicle upon highways, streets, or roadways of this state without a valid policy of liability insurance in effect in an amount not less than that provided in 61-6-301 or unless such person has been issued a certificate of self-insurance pursuant to 61-6-143 or has previously posted an indemnity bond with the division of motor vehicles as provided by 61-6-301 or is operating a vehicle exempt under 61-6-303. A violation of 61-6-301 through 61-6-304 is a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to exceed \$250 \$500 or imprisonment in the county jail for a term not to exceed 6 wonths or both such fine and imprisonment."

Section 4. Section 61-7-111, MCA, is amended to read:

"61-7-111. Accident report forms. (1) The division
shall prepare and, upon request, supply to police
departments, coroners, medical examiners, sheriffs, garages,
and other suitable agencies or individuals forms for
accident reports required hereunder, appropriate with
respect to the persons required to make such reports and the
purposes to be served. The written reports to be made by
persons involved in accidents and by investigating officers
shall call for sufficiently detailed information to disclose
with reference to a traffic accident the causes, conditions
then existing, and the persons and vehicles involved.

(2) Every accident report required to be made in writing shall be made on the appropriate form approved by the division and shall contain all of the information required therein unless not available.

(3) The division may suspend the license or permit to drive of any resident or the nonresident operating privilege of any person failing to report an accident as herein provided until such report has been filed. Any person convicted of failing to report an accident by the quickest means of communication or failing to forward a written report as required herein is guilty of a misdemeanor and punishable by a fine of not more less than \$25 \$10 or more than \$100."
