15 highway user fees, registration fees, permit fees, fuel
16 taxes, or any other fees and taxes that may be prescribed by
17 law or rule. An agreement may further provide for the
18 construction and joint operation of ports of entry along
19 state borders.

party state of highway user fees, registration fees, permit
fees, fuel taxes, or any other fees and taxes that may be
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for the construction and joint operation of ports of entry
along state borders.
