4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO REQUIRE CONTRACTORS  
5 ON STATE CONSTRUCTION, RENOVATION, OR DEMOLITION PROJECTS TO  
6 PARTICIPATE IN APPROVED APPRENTICESHIP TRAINING PROGRAMS."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9 Section 1. Apprenticeship training program required  
10 for state contractors. (1) In this section, the definitions  
11 of "building" and "construction" in 18-2-101 apply.

12 (2) The department of administration may not award or  
13 recommend for award a contract for construction, renovation,  
14 or demolition of a state building that is anticipated to  
15 cost \$2,000 or more to a person who does not participate in  
16 and is not signatory to an apprenticeship training program  
17 approved by the department of labor and industry.

18 (3) A mandatory condition in any contract for  
19 construction, renovation, or demolition of a state building  
20 is that any subcontract awarded thereunder may be awarded  
21 only to a subcontractor who participates in and is signatory  
22 to an apprenticeship training program approved by the  
23 department of labor and industry.

24 (4) Failure of a contractor or subcontractor to  
25 maintain participation in an approved apprenticeship

1 training program during the term of the contract is  
2 sufficient cause to terminate the contract.
