BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Costs of defense to be awarded. In any civil action brought after October 1, 1983, against a health care provider based upon a malpractice claim for which the panel has determined that the patient was not injured by the malpractice of the provider, the court shall award the provider its reasonable attorney fees in addition to costs provided for in 25-10-102.

Section 2. Codification instruction. Section 1 is intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 27, chapter 6, part 7, and the provisions of Title 27, chapter 6, apply to section 1.
