- 9 Section 1. Section 90-6-204, MCA, is amended to read:
 10 "90-6-204. Chairman, meetings, compensation, and
 11 facilities. (1) The board shall elect a chairman from among

its members.

- (2) The board shall meet quarterly and may meet at other times as called by the chairman or a majority of the members.
- (3) Members are entitled to compensation as provided for in 2-15-124(7), except that each member who is not a full-time salaried officer or employee of this state or of a political subdivision of this state is entitled to be paid \$50 for each day in which he is actually and necessarily engaged in the performance of his duties.
