8 WHEREAS, Montana is the home of one of the world's most 9 important dinosaur discoveries, specifically the duck-billed 10 dinosaur Maiasaura peeblesorum, which is found nowhere else 11 in the world; and

12 WHEREAS, the duck-billed dinosaur, when newly hatched, 13 was less than 14 inches long and weighed about 1 1/2 pounds 14 but grew to over 30 feet in length and weighed about 3 tons; 15 and

16 ¥HEREAS, dinosaur sites in Montana contain fossilized 17 eggs, embryonic bone, babies, juveniles, and adults of 18 several different types of dinosaurs; provide valuable 19 evidence that duck-billed dinosaurs nested in extensive 20 colonies and had nests 6 feet in diameter that contained as 21 many as 20 eggs; and demonstrate for the first time parental 22 care of dinosaur young; and

23 WHEREAS, the Montana discoveries have tremendous
24 scientific value and will continue to receive widespread
25 publicity in national and international journals, as well as

in popular literature and television and radio programs; and
 WHEREAS, naming a dinosaur as the state fossil will
 increase awareness that Montana is one of the best places in
 the world for the occurrence of important dinosaur
 discoveries and will have real economic value in terms of
 tourist promotion; and

WHEREAS, the name Maiasaura peeblesorum means "good
mother lizard" (Maiasaura) and honors the Peebles family
(peeblesorum), a Montana ranch family from the Choteau area
where the discoveries were made.
