BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 7-32-2209, MCA, is amended to read:

"7-32-2209. Expenses of persons committed to jail by
highway patrol bureau. In the event a person is committed to
jail by the highway patrol bureau, department of justice,
the state of Montana shall, upon claim presented for the
county by the clerk and recorder, pay into the county
treasury of the county the sum of \$10 \$32 per day for each
and every prisoner held in the county jail upon order or
commitment of the highway patrol bureau or any department or
officer thereof. For the purposes of this section, a day
shall be defined as a 24-hour period or portion thereof,
beginning with the time of incarceration. Such claims upon
the highway patrol bureau, department of justice, shall be
paid to the various counties out of funds appropriated for
that purpose."

## DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

House Bill 476 raises the daily rate to be paid by the state to the county for persons placed in a county jail by the highway patrol.

#### ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1) Highway patrol jail commitment cost for FY-82 was \$45,496 and is used as a basis.
- 2) The current cost per day is \$10. This bill would increase this to \$35 per day.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 7-32-2209, MCA, is amended to read:

"7-32-2209. Expenses of persons committed to jail by
highway patrol bureau. In the event a person is committed to
jail by the highway patrol bureau, department of justice,
the state of Montana shall, upon claim presented for the
county by the clerk and recorder, pay into the county
treasury of the county the sum of \$10.535 per day for each
and every prisoner held in the county jail upon order or
commitment of the highway patrol bureau or any department or
officer thereof. For the purposes of this section, a day
shall be defined as a 24-hour period or portion thereof,
beginning with the time of incarceration. Such claims upon
the highway patrol bureau, department of justice, shall be
paid to the various counties out of funds appropriated for
that purpose."
