INTRODUCED BY  
A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO RAISE THE DAILY RATE TO BE PAID BY THE STATE TO THE COUNTY FOR PERSONS PLACED IN A COUNTY JAIL BY THE HIGHWAY PATROL; AMENDING SECTION 7-32-2209, MCA."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 7-32-2209, MCA, is amended to read:

"7-32-2209. Expenses of persons committed to jail by highway patrol bureau. In the event a person is committed to jail by the highway patrol bureau, department of justice, the state of Montana shall, upon claim presented for the county by the clerk and recorder, pay into the county treasury of the county the sum of ~~\$10~~ \$22 per day for each and every prisoner held in the county jail upon order or commitment of the highway patrol bureau or any department or officer thereof. For the purposes of this section, a day shall be defined as a 24-hour period or portion thereof, beginning with the time of incarceration. Such claims upon the highway patrol bureau, department of justice, shall be paid to the various counties out of funds appropriated for that purpose."

## FISCAL NOTE

Form BD-15

In compliance with a written request received January 27, 19 83, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for House Bill 476 pursuant to Chapter 53, Laws of Montana, 1965 - Thirty-Ninth Legislative Assembly. Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

House Bill 476 raises the daily rate to be paid by the state to the county for persons placed in a county jail by the highway patrol.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1) Highway patrol jail commitment cost for FY-82 was \$45,496 and is used as a basis.
- 2) The current cost per day is \$10. This bill would increase this to \$35 per day.



LOCAL IMPACT:

County treasurers will receive an additional \$25.00 for every highway patrol jail commitment, which is the same amount that the state will be paying, or \$113,740.
