A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO ALLOW A PERSON MAKING AN ARREST TO BRING THE ARRESTED PERSON BEFORE A JUDGE OF THE COUNTY NEAREST TO THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE WARRANT WAS ISSUED IF THE ISSUING JUDGE IS ABSENT OR UNABLE TO ACT; AMENDING SECTION 46-7-101, MCA."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 46-7-101, MCA, is amended to reads "46-7-101. Bringing arrested person before a court.

(1) Any person making an arrest under a warrant shall take the arrested person without unnecessary delay before the judge issuing the warrant or, if he is absent or unable to act, before the nearest or most accessible judge of the same or nearest county. If an arrest is made in a county other than the one in which the warrant was issued, the arrested person shall be taken without unnecessary delay before the nearest and most accessible judge in the county where the arrest was made.

(2) Any person making an arrest without a warrant shall take the arrested person without unnecessary delay before the nearest or most accessible judge in the same county, and a complaint stating the charges against the

arrested person shall be filed forthwith. -End-
