A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO ALLOW HIGHWAY PATROL OFFICERS TO PERFORM DUTIES IN CONNECTION WITH LABOR DISPUTES UPON REQUEST OF LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITIES; AMENDING SECTION 44-1-1002, MCA."

 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 44-1-1002, MCA, is amended to read:

"44-1-1002. No authority in labor disputes. Such
highway Highway patrolmen have no authority and are
expressly forbidden to make arrests in labor disputes or to
prevent violence in connection with strikes and may not
perform any duties whatsoever in connection with labor
disputes, strikes, or boycotts unless the sheriff of the
county or chief law enforcement officer of the municipality
in which the labor dispute, strike, or boycott occurs
requests highway patrol assistance from the chief
administrator of the highway patrol."
