 3 from the general fund for each of the fiscal years ending
 4 June 30, 1984, and June 30, 1985, for special commodity
 5 distribution. This appropriation must be allocated by the
 6 Department of Social and Rehabilitation Services to its
 7 contractors, including Human Resource Development Councils,
 8 that distribute special commodities. The funds allocation
 9 shall be based upon the amounts of such commodities
 10 distributed by each contractor.

WHEREAS, the distribution of special commodity cheese

WHEREAS, the transportation, storage, and coordination
of commodity distributions represent costs that are

significant to the state and to local distribution
organizations, although these costs are small in comparison
to the value of commodities distributed; and

WHEREAS, the value of continuing and supporting special
commodity distributions is underscored by Montana's present
economic and unemployment situation and the resultant
participation of Montanans in the program; and

WHEREAS, it has been indicated that additional special
commodity foods will be available in the near future.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Appropriation. There is appropriated to the
Department of Social and Rehabilitation Services \$150,000
from the general fund COMMUNITY SERVICES BLOCK GRANT for
each of the fiscal years ending June 30, 1984, and June 30,
1985, for special commodity distribution. This
