DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

House Bill 544 increases maximum general fund budget schedules for elementary and high schools by 12% in FY 1984 and 12% in FY 1985.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1) Excludes special education.
- 2) \$32 million of general fund left in school equalization account in FY 1983.
- Revenue generated per revised Office of Budget and Program Planning estimates (February 1, 1983).
- 4) District share of permissive stable at 69.5% of revenues from the 15 mill levy.
- 5) Includes light vehicle fees and replacement funds.

COMMENT:

Unlike the fiscal note on House Bill 204, this note includes revenue from the light vehicle replacement fund.

LONG TERM EFFECT:

Because this bill substantially increases public school base funding, the effect on future funding is important. The following chart shows the dollar growth between the 84-85 biennium (at 12% to 12%) and the projected cost in FY 1986-87 at 0% to 0%.

If this legislation is enacted, the cost of the same 1985 schedule in FY 1986 and 1987 will be \$37.339 million more than the proposed 12% schedules in 84 and 85.
