INTRODUCED BY JULY

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT PROVIDING THAT A LOCAL GOVERNMENT MAY NOT IMPOUND A MOTOR VEHICLE FOR NONPAYMENT OF A PARKING VIOLATION UNLESS IT CAN PROVE THE VEHICLE WAS UNDER THE CONTROL OF THE OWNER WHEN IT WAS PARKED; AND LIMITING THE CHARGE FOR STORAGE OF AN IMPOUNDED VEHICLE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Limitation on impounding vehicles. Notwithstanding the provisions of 7-14-4628 and 61-12-101, a local government, including a self-governing local government, may not impound a motor vehicle for nonpayment of a parking violation unless the local government can prove in a judicial proceeding that the vehicle was under the physical control of the owner when the vehicle was parked. Section 2. Charges for impounded vehicle. A local government impounding a vehicle for nonpayment of parking violations pursuant to [section 1] may charge the owner of the vehicle an amount not greater than the actual cost of towing plus \$5 per day in storage fees for each day of the impoundment.
