13 the state liquor store shall be made by the department for
14 sales of liquor to any person purchasing liquor in unbroken
15 case lots. No other reduction shall be made by the
16 department for quantity sales of liquor."

In compliance with a written request received February 2, 19 83, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for House Bill 563 pursuant to Chapter 53, Laws of Montana, 1965 - Thirty-Ninth Legislative Assembly. Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

House Bill 563 increases from 5% to 10% the discount on the purchase from the state liquor store of unbroken case lots of liquor.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1) Gross sales, cost of goods, operating and administrative expenses, and taxes will all remain at the level reported for FY 82.
- 2) Doubling the discount rate will increase the proportion of sales at discount, from 34.7 percent of gross sales to approximately 40 percent of gross sales, an increase of 15 percent.
