14 (2) The application must be made by the local 15 government owning and operating the public golf course. The 16 local government may lease the license for use at the golf 17 course to an individual or entity approved by the 18 department.

(3) A municipal golf course beer and wine license and
all retail beer and wine sales thereunder are subject to all
statutes and rules governing a retail beer license with a
wine license amendment.

(4) The department of revenue shall issue a municipal
 golf course beer and wine license to a qualified applicant
 regardless of the number of beer and wine licenses already

issued within the beer and wine license quota area in which
 the golf course is situated.

3 Section 2. Codification instruction. Section 1 is 4 intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 16, 5 chapter 4, part 1, and the provisions of Title 16, chapters 6 1 through 6, apply to section 1.
