Submission to electorate. 14 This amendment shall be submitted to the electors of the 15 state of Montana at the general election to be held in 16 November 1984 by printing on the ballot the full title, 17 section 1 of this act; and the following: FOR requiring removal of a judge who fails to impose 18 19 a criminal sentence as required by law. 20 AGAINST requiring removal of a judge who fails to 21 impose a criminal sentence as required by law.
