BF IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Appropriation -- administration. (1) There is appropriated to the Board of Crime Control \$4,522,462 from the general fund to provide grants by the Board to local governments for the conversion of public safety land mobile communications from the low-band frequency spectrum to the high-band frequency spectrum.

(2) In administering the grant of money under this appropriation, the Board may make preconditions for grant awards, including type of equipment, equipment expenditures, fiscal accountability, and other conditions conducive to oilaua safety and prudent administration of the appropriation. The Board may set priorities for awarding grants to particular areas and types of services it

1 determines are in the best interest of public safety.

2 (3) All equipment purchased with a grant awarded under 3 this act becomes the property of the local government. The local government is responsible for maintenance, repair, and replacement of such equipment.
