DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

House Bill 639 transfers from the Department of Administration to the Department of Commerce the functions of generally assisting political subdivisions, exercising oversight of financial and reporting systems, supervising records retention and performing audits. These functions are performed by the Local Government Services Division which would move to the Department of Commerce.

ASSUMPTIONS:

1) Biennial budget of \$5,987,723 with 38 FTE's will be transferred intact to the Department of Commerce. The budget includes \$3,500,000 for District Court assistance.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Total operating budgets will remain the same after being merged with the Department of Commerce.
