5 ENGINEERING TECHNOLOGY TRAINING TO QUALIFY FOR CERTIFICATION
6 AS AN ENGINEER-IN-TRAINING; AND REMOVING A CURRICULUM
7 APPROVAL REQUIREMENT; AMENDING SECTION 37-67-307, MCA."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 Section 1. Section 37-67-307, MCA, is amended to read:

11 "37-67-307. Qualifications of applicant for
12 registration as engineer-in-training. The following shall be
13 considered as minimum evidence that the applicant is
14 qualified for certification as an engineer-in-training:

15 (1) A graduate of an engineering ~~or~~ engineering
16 technology curriculum of 4 years or more, ~~approved-by-the~~
17 ~~board-as-being-of-satisfactory-standing,~~ shall be admitted
18 to an 8-hour written examination in the fundamentals of
19 engineering. Upon passing such examination, the applicant
20 shall be certified or enrolled as an engineer-in-training if
21 he is otherwise qualified.

22 (2) A graduate of ~~an-engineering-or~~ a related science
23 curriculum of 4 years or more, other than the ~~ones--approved~~
24 ~~by--the--board-as-being-satisfactory-standing~~ engineering or
25 engineering technology, with a specific record of 4 or more

1 years of progressive experience on engineering projects of a
2 grade and character satisfactory to the board shall be
3 admitted to an 8-hour written examination in the
4 fundamentals of engineering. Upon passing such examination,
5 the applicant shall be certified or enrolled as an
6 engineer-in-training if he is otherwise qualified."
