(5) The department of administration shall keep and maintain the physical structure and location of the supreme court chambers which were occupied by the Montana Supreme Court until the new justice building was completed and dedicated in 1983 as a single room which shall be used for legislative committee purposes. Such room shall not be divided in any manner and the artwork and the height of the ceiling shall be maintained and

preserved.

(2) The committee shall consult with and advise the department of administration concerning the assignment of space in the capitol complex and the actual placement of busts, statues, memorials, or art displays of a permanent nature within public areas of the capitol complex. No such item may be permanently displayed unless authorized by the legislature.
