BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 23-5-101, MCA, is amended to read:

"23-5-101. Definitions. (I) A slot machine is defined
as a any machine. apparatus. or device that is operated by
inserting. a depositing. or placing with another person any
coin, token, chip, trade check, or paper currency. therein
by-the-player-and-from-the-play-of-which-he-obteins-or-may
obtain or other object if. as a result of such operation. by
reason of any element of chance. the user may receive or
hecome entitled to money, checks, chips, tokens, or paper
currency redeemable in money or anything of value.
irrespective of whether the machine, apparatus, or device
also may sell, delivers or present money, merchandise, or
other tangible or intangible thing of value. Merchandise

"23-5-302. Definitions. As used in this part and

- (1) "Authorized card game" means any card game permitted by this part but does not include any game played on or with any machines apparatuse electronic devices or other instrument which purports to simulate a card game permitted by this part.

Section 3. Section 23-5-311. MCA, is amended to read:

authorized by this part.

"23-5-411. Bingo and raffles authorized == exceptions.

Conducting (11 Except as provided in subsection (21) conducting or participating in games of chance as defined in 23-5-402 and in accordance with the provisions of this part is lawful.

(2) It is unlawful for a person to maintain or operate

any machines apparatuse electronic devices or other

instrument that simulates or purports to simulate the games

of chance defined in 23-5-402."
