## DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

House Bill 674 is an act to provide continued retirement coverage for firemen while they are on disability and receiving payments from the Workers' Compensation Division as well as the employing city by including the workers' compensation payment as part of the calculations of monthly contributions.

## ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1) There is only one case since July 1, 1981 that would have been effected by this bill. It is not possible to project how many cases may occur in the future.
- 2) The long term fiscal impact is assumed to be minimal.
- 3) It has been assumed that a single case will be illustrative of the potential fiscal impact in the future.
