4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT PROVIDING THAT REAR  
5 BUMPER HEIGHT OF PASSENGER VEHICLES AND PICKUPS BE NO MORE  
6 THAN 19 INCHES ABOVE THE ROAD SURFACE; AND PROVIDING A  
7 DELAYED EFFECTIVE DATE."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 Section 1. Height of bumpers. After December 31, 1983,  
11 no person may move any private passenger vehicle or pickup  
12 truck of 3/4-ton rating or less upon the public roads,  
13 highways, or streets of this state unless it has a rear  
14 bumper attached to the vehicle no more than 19 inches above  
15 the road surface.

16 Section 2. Codification instruction. Section 1 is  
17 intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 61,  
18 chapter 9, part 4, and the provisions of Title 61, chapter  
19 9, apply to section 1.

20 Section 3. Effective date. This act is effective on  
21 January 1, 1984.
