1 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO

THE DEPARTMENT OF INSTITUTIONS TO CONVERT THE GAS-FIRED 5

HEATING PLANT AT THE PINE HILLS SCHOOL TO A COAL-FIRED

PLANT." 7

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Appropriation. The following money is appropriated from the long-range building fund bond proceeds clearance account to the Department of Institutions for the conversion of the gas-fired heating system at the Pine Hills School to a coal-fired heating system:

\$1,300,000 For the biennium ending June 30, 1985 Section 2. Conditions. (1) This appropriation is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) As soon as practicable, but no later than October 1, 1983, the Department shall convert the existing gas-fired heating plant at the Pine Hills School to a coal-fired heating plant.
- (b) The Department shall keep and maintain detailed records of the costs of operating the coal-fired heating plant for a period of 12 months following installation and shall provide these, along with past records on the

1 operating costs of the existing gas-fired plant, to the 2 Legislative Fiscal Analyst on or before November 1: 1984.

3 (2) Upon receipt of the records, the Legislative 4 Fiscal Analyst shall conduct an analysis of the comparative 5 operating costs of the coal-fired and gas-fired heating plants and shall report the findings to the 49th 7 Legislature.

1	Section 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated to th
5	department of administration from the funds received fro

6	Section 3. Procedures and restrictions. (1) Before the
7	conversion for which the bond issue under [section 1] is
8	made may take place, the following conditions and procedures
9	must be met:
10	(a) The department of administration shall request
11	engineering design proposals for conversion of the gas-fired
12	heating plant at the Pine Hills school to a coal-fired
13	system. The request must require all submitted proposals to
14	(i) provide a system that is as fully automated as
15	present technology can provide;
16	(ii) provide for particulate emission control of the
17	system that achieves at least 85-95% efficiency;
18	(iii) use existing gas-fired boilers for standby and
19	emergency purposes; and

(iv) provide coal-receiving capacity for at least 33

(b) (i) The department shall enter a contract for coal

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(A) is contingent upon successful completion of the conversion of the Pine Hills system under the provisions of [this act];

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- 4 (8) notwithstanding 18-4-10Z, has a contract term of not less than 10 years;
- 6 (C) requires payment for the coal at market price or 7 lower each year, but not to exceed an 8% increase over the 8 previous year's price; and
- 9 (D) provides for coal that has a minimum heating value of 8,700 BTU/lb.
  - (ii) Provision for delivery of the coal to Pine Hills school may be included in the coal contract or in a separate contract; however, the initial combined price of coal and delivery may not exceed \$22 acton.
  - (c) After receipt of proposals under subsection (1)(a), the department shall review them and determine which proposal best meets the criteria established in that subsection, will result in annual cost savings to the state of Montana after the conversion is complete, and will repaybonds sold under [section 1] within 12 years from their date of issuance. To determine annual cost savings, the department shall consider:
    - (i) the requirements of subsection (1)(b);
- (ii) the forecasted natural gas rates as presented bythe Pine Hills school utility provider to the Montana public
