 - (15) Any reference to "municipality", "city", or "town" includes those jurisdictions which, prior to the effective date of a county-municipal consolidation, were incorporated municipalities, subsequent districts created for urban firefighting services, or the entire county included in the county-municipal consolidation.
- (16) "Part-paid firefighter" means a person employed 16 17 under 7-33-4109 who receives compensation in excess of \$300 18 a year for his service as a firefighter.
- 19 (17) "Plan" means the municipal firefighters* retirement system created by this chapter. 20
- (18) "Prior plan" means the fire department relief 21 association plan of a city that elects to join the plan 22 23 under 19-13-108 or the fire department relief association 24 plan of a city of the first or second class.
- (19) "Prior service" means a period of employment as a 25

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- (20) "Retirement allowance" means the monthly benefit payable after service or disability retirement.
- (21) "Retirement date" means the date on which the first payment of the retirement or disability benefits of a member or a beneficlary is payable.
- (22) "Totally and permanently disabled" means that the board, upon certification by a licensed and practicing physician, has determined that a member's disability is of such a nature as to permanently impair his ability to discharge his normal duties as a firefighter."
