DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

House Bill 767 revises license fees for health care facilities to a standard charge per bed at the facility; amends Section 50-5-202, MCA; and provides an applicability date.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1) Currently, there's a \$20 minimum plus \$1.00 per bed in excess of 20 beds.
- 2) Estimate was derived from using the facility with the largest number of beds (Great Fall Deaconess 282 beds) at a cost of \$1,000. With this formula, a figure of \$3.55 per bed was derived.
- 3) The total number of licensed beds in the state is 10,174.
