In compliance with a written request received February 15, 19 83, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for House Bill 767 pursuant to Title 5, Chapter 4, Part 2 of the Montana Code Annotated (MCA).

Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

House Bill 767 revises license fees for health care facilities to a standard charge per bed at the facility; amends Section 50-5-202, MCA; and provides an applicability date.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1) Currently, there's a \$20 minimum plus \$1.00 per bed in excess of 20 beds.
- 2) Estimate was derived from using the facility with the largest number of beds (Great Fall Deaconess - 282 beds) at a cost of \$1,000. With this formula, a figure of \$3.55 per bed was derived.
- 3) The total number of licensed beds in the state is 10,174.

TECHNICAL NOTE:

Under current law, 29 non-bedded licensed facilities pay \$20.00 per year in license fees. The proposal removes these facilities from all license fees.
