A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: MAN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR 3
CONSECUTIVE DAYS OF NURSING HOME PAYMENTS FOR NURSING HOME
PATIENTS WHO ARE HOSPITALIZED; AND TO PROVIDE THAT THE
DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL AND REHABILITATION SERVICES MAY BY RULE
ESTABLISH THE AGGREGATE NUMBER OF DAYS A YEAR THAT PAYMENTS
MAY BE MADE FOR A PATIENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Payment for nursing home care while patient hospitalized. (1) Subject to aggregate yearly totals established under subsection (2), the department shall make payments to skilled nursing facilities and intermediate care facilities for patients who are authorized to leave such a facility for hospitalization for diagnostic or treatment services for a period not to exceed 3 consecutive days.

department may by rule establish the aggregate number of days a year per patient for which such payment is to be made. The department may categorize patients based upon their physical or mental disease in setting the number of days a year payments are to be made.
