BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Fencing or bridging across navigable streams. (1) An owner or lessee of land adjoining a stream that is navigable under 85-1-112 may:

- (a) extend a fenceline across the stream for the purpose of containing livestock; and
- (b) build a bridge across the stream for the transportation of people, livestock, and vehicles.
- (2) An owner or lessee extending a fenceline across a navigable stream must attach to and maintain on the fence from May 1 through Bctober 31 of each year one or more warning signs, markers, or devices reasonably sufficient to warn any person on the river that he is approaching the fence.
- (3) An owner or lessee extending a fenceline or building a bridge across a navigable stream must post and maintain a sion from May 1 through October 31 of each year

1 on an upstream bank of the stream in a place readily visible 2 to a person approaching the sign. The sign must be posted at the first upstream point along the stream more than 100 yards from the fence or bridge at which a watercraft may be easily landed upon the shore. The sign must be at least 4 square feet in area and contain the word "fence" or "bridge", as appropriate, in red block lettering at least 16 inches high on a white background.
