BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA: 11

12 Section 1. Section 87-2-101, MCA, is amended to read: 13 "87-2-101. Definitions. As used in this chapter and chapter 3. unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, 14 the following definitions apply: 15

(1) "Angling" or "Fishing" means the taking of or 15 attempting to take fish by hook and single line or single 17 rod, in hand or within immediate control. 18

19 (2) "Closed season" means the time during which game birds. fish, and game and fur-bearing animals may not be 20 21 lawfully taken.

22 (3) "Commission" means the state fish and game 23 commission.

(4) "Fur-bearing animals" means marten or sable, 24 25 otter. muskrat, fisher, mink, bobcat, lynx, wolverine,

1 northern swift fox, and beaver.

2 (5) "Game animals" means deer, elk, moose, antelope, 3 caribou, mountain sheep, mountain goat, mountain lion, and 4 bears_except_grizzly_bear.

5 (6) "Game fish" means all species of the family salmonidae (chars, trout, salmon, grayling, and whitefish); 7 all species of the genus stizostedion (sandpike or sauger and walleyed pike or yellowpike perch); all species of the 8 9 genus esox (northern pike, pickerel, and muskellunge); all species of the genus micropterus (bass); all species of the 10 11 genus polyodon (paddlefish); all species of the family 12 acipenseridae (sturgeon); all species of the genus lota (burbot or ling); and the species ictalurus punctatus 13 14 (channel catfish).

15 (7) "Migratory game birds" means waterfowl, including 16 wild ducks, wild geese, brant, and swans; cranes, including 17 little brown and sandhill; rails, including coots; wilson's 18 snipes or lacksnipes.

(8) "Nongame wildlife" means any wild mammal, bird, 19 amphibian, reptlle, fish, mollusk, crustacean, or other 20 animal not otherwise legally classified by statute or 21 22 regulation of this state.

23 (9) "Open season" means the time during which game 24 birds, fish, dame and fur-bearing animals may be lawfully 25 taken.
