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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

14 Section 1. Section 39-3-406, MCA, is amended to read:
15 #39-3-406. Exclusions. (1) The provisions of 39-3-404
16 and 39-3-405 shall not apply with respect to:

- (a) students participating in a distributive education program established under the auspices of an accredited educational agency;
- 20 (b) persons employed in private homes whose duties
  21 consist of menial chores such as babysitting, moving lawns,
  22 cleaning sidewalks:
- (c) persons employed directly by the head of a household to care for children dependent upon the head of the household;

(d) immediate members of the family of an employer or
persons dependent upon an employer for half or more of their
support in the customary sense of being a dependent;

- (e) any persons not regular employees thereof who voluntarily offer their services to a nonprofit organization on a fully or partially reimbursed basis;
- (f) handicapped workers engaged in work which is incidental to training or evaluation programs or whose earning capacity is so severely impaired that they are unable to engage in competitive employment;
- (g) apprentices or learners, who may be exempted by the commissioner for a period not to exceed 30 days of their employment;
- 14 (h) learners under the age of 18 who are employed as
  15 farm workers, provided that such exclusion shall not exceed
  16 a period of 180 days from their initial date of employment
  17 and further provided that during this exclusion period wages
  18 paid such learners may not be less than 50% of the minimum
  19 wage rate established in this part;
- 20 (i) retired or semiretired persons performing
  21 part-time incidental work as a condition of their residence
  22 on a farm or ranch;
- 23 (j) any individual employed in a bona fide executive.
  24 administrative, or professional capacity as these terms are
  25 defined and delimited by regulations of the commissioner;

(k) any individual employed by the United States of
America.
