A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO PERMIT AN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL DISTRICT AND A HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT REPRESENTING TWO SEPARATE SOCIAL SECURITY REPORTING ENTITIES TO MERGE INTO A SINGLE REPORTING ENTITY; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Merger of reporting entities. If the approval of referenda at different times results in the establishment of two separate social security reporting entities for a high school district and an elementary school district and the high school building is located in the elementary school district, the state agency shall, upon request of the boards of trustees in both districts, merge the two reporting entities to form a single reporting entity if the elementary school district and high school district:

(1) have boards of trustees of which a majority of each board is composed of the same persons;

(2) are administered by the same executive officer; and

(3) have payroll calculations made in the same payroll application.

Section 2. Codification instruction. Section 1 is intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 19, chapter 1, part 8, and the provisions of Title 19, chapter 1, apply to section 1.

Section 3. Effective date. This act is effective on passage and approval.
