BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Settlement offer refused — right to prejudgment interest — exception. (1) In an action to recover damages for personal injury, wrongful death, or injury to property in which the plaintiff makes a written offer of settlement of the action that is not accepted by the defendant within 30 days of its receipt or before the commencement of trial, whichever occurs first, and in which action the plaintiff obtains a judgment for damages greater than previously offered in writing to the defendant, the plaintiff is entitled to interest on the judgment at the rate of 10% a year from the date the action was filed.

(2) Subsection (1) does not apply to actions brought or claims made against the state or a political subdivision under fitle 2, chapter 9, part 3.

Section 2. Applicability date. This act does not apply to any claim made or action brought prior to October 1.
