25 (2) Upon selecting a design for the statue, the

council shall contract for the construction of the statue in
accordance with the laws and regulations of the United
States pertaining to such matters.

4 (3) Upon completion, the Montana arts council shall 5 furnish the statue to the appropriate representative of the 6 United States, to be placed in the national statuary hall in 7 the capitol in Washington, D+C+

8 Section Z. Appropriation. (1) There is appropriated 9 \$47,000 to the Montana arts council in spending authority 10 for the purpose of casting and placing a statue of Jeanette 11 Rankin in the national statuary hall in the capitol in 12 Washington, D.C.

13 (2) There is appropriated from the general fund 14 \$31,500 to the Montana arts council for the purpose stated 15 in subsection (1). The appropriation in this subsection is 16 contingent upon the Montana arts council raising funds in 17 the amount of \$15,500 from private donations. If such funds 18 do not become available, the appropriated funds shall revert 19 to the general fund.
