9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 Saction 1. Rallroad safety investigations —
11 participation with United States secretary of transportation
12 — rail inspector. (1) The commission shall, under the
13 appointment power granted the commission by 69-1-109,

(2) The rail inspector shall:
