4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE \$75,000  
5 FROM THE COAL TAX CULTURAL AND AESTHETIC ACCOUNT FOR  
6 CONTRIBUTION TOWARD THE PURCHASE OF THE MOSS MANSION,  
7 LOCATED IN BILLINGS, MONTANA; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE  
8 EFFECTIVE DATE."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11 Section 1. Appropriation for purchase of Moss Mansion.  
12 (1) There is appropriated \$75,000 from the coal tax cultural  
13 and aesthetic account in the earmarked revenue fund to the  
14 Montana Historical Society for the biennium ending June 30,  
15 1985, for the purpose of contributing toward the purchase of  
16 the Moss Mansion located in Billings, Montana.

17 (2) The funds appropriated in subsection (1) shall be  
18 contributed by the Montana Historical Society to the city of  
19 Billings for the purchase of the Moss Mansion when the city  
20 of Billings has received a \$500,000 contribution from the  
21 Moss family and has an additional \$75,000 with which to  
22 purchase the Moss Mansion. If such local funding is not  
23 obtained by June 30, 1985, the funds appropriated in  
24 subsection (1) revert to the account from which they were  
25 appropriated.

1 Section 2. Effective date. This act is effective on  
2 passage and approval.
