A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE \$419,520 TO THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL AND REHABILITATION SERVICES FOR INCREASING STATE SUPPLEMENTS TO CERTAIN ELIGIBLE SUPPLEMENTAL SECURITY INCOME RECIPIENTS RECEIVING PERSONAL CARE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Appropriation. (1) There is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Social and Rehabilitation Services \$182,400 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1984, and \$237,120 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1985, for the purpose provided in subsection (2).

(2) The appropriation in subsection (1) is for the purpose of increasing the state supplement to eligible supplemental security income recipients receiving personal care:

(a) in a roominghouse or retirement home as defined in 50-51-102(5) that is licensed under the provisions of Title 50, chapter 51; or

(b) if Senate Bill 446 is passed by the 48th Legislature and approved, in a personal care facility licensed pursuant to Senate Bill 446.
