2 INTRODUCED BY Nishet Rastoria Bergene  
3 Richard E. Manning Christiane M. Connick  
4 A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF  
5 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA URGING THE PRESIDENT  
6 AND THE CONGRESS OF THE UNITED STATES TO REQUIRE APPROPRIATE  
7 DISASTER SHELTER IN PUBLIC BUILDINGS BUILT WITH FEDERAL  
8 FUNDS.

10 WHEREAS, it is acknowledged that there is generally  
11 insufficient protection in the event of natural or man-made  
12 disasters; and

13 WHEREAS, there is a considerable body of knowledge  
14 indicating that survival is possible in the event of such  
15 disasters given adequate protection; and

16 WHEREAS, billions of dollars have been expended to  
17 protect key military installations and high-level government  
18 personnel.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE  
21 OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

22 That the Montana Legislature supports the announced  
23 intention of the Honorable Ron Marlenee, Congressman from  
24 the Second Congressional District, to seek federal  
25 legislation requiring appropriate shelter in all new public

1 buildings financed wholly or partially with federal funds to  
2 maximize population protection from natural or man-made  
3 disasters.

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of State  
5 send copies of this resolution to the President of the  
6 United States and to Montana's Congressional Delegation.
