6 A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF  
7 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA REQUESTING  
8 PROPORTIONAL ALLOCATION BY THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION  
9 TO THE LEGISLATURE OF SPACE AVAILABLE IN THE CAPITOL.

11 WHEREAS, the removal to the Justice Building of the  
12 Supreme Court, the Law Library, and the Attorney General  
13 caused vacancies in the Capitol in the spaces formerly  
14 occupied by and used by the Supreme Court, the Law Library,  
15 and the Attorney General; and

16 WHEREAS, the Legislature, for the conduct of its  
17 business, requires adequate and suitable space for the  
18 Senate and for the House of Representatives, for the  
19 committees of both the Senate and the House, and for offices  
20 for the leadership and members of both the Senate and the  
21 House; and

22 WHEREAS, equitable allocation requires that available  
23 space be assigned in relationship to the number of members  
24 and the corresponding office requirements in each body and  
25 in relationship to the needs of each body for committee

1 rooms; and

2 WHEREAS, the Department of Administration, pursuant to  
3 section 2-17-101, MCA, has the responsibility to assign  
4 space in state office buildings.

6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE  
7 OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

8 That the Department of Administration, when assigning  
9 to the Legislature space vacated by the Supreme Court, the  
10 Law Library, and the Attorney General:

11 (1) allocate committee rooms equally between the  
12 Senate and the House of Representatives; and

13 (2) allocate space available for office purposes  
14 between the House of Representatives and the Senate in  
15 proportion to the number of members in each body.

A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA REQUESTING PROPORTIONAL ALLOCATION BY THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION TO THE LEGISLATURE OF SPACE AVAILABLE IN THE CAPITOL.

WHEREAS, the removal to the Justice Building of the Supreme Court, the Law Library, and the Attorney General caused vacancies in the Capitol in the spaces formerly occupied by and used by the Supreme Court, the Law Library, and the Attorney General; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature, for the conduct of its business, requires adequate and suitable space for the Senate and for the House of Representatives, for the committees of both the Senate and the House, and for offices for the leadership and members of both the Senate and the House; and

WHEREAS, equitable allocation requires that available space be assigned in relationship to the number of members and the corresponding office requirements in each body and in relationship to the needs of each body for committee

rooms; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Administration, pursuant to section 2-17-101, MCA, has the responsibility to assign space in state office buildings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

That the Department of Administration, when assigning to the Legislature space vacated by the Supreme Court, the Law Library, and the Attorney General:

(1) allocate committee rooms equally between the Senate and the House of Representatives; and

(2) allocate space available for office purposes between the House of Representatives and the Senate in proportion to the number of members in each body.
